

Reference Marking and Citation

The reference list should not be alphabetically ordered, but it should match the order in which the references appear in the open text. Reference numbers are in square brackets. **Font:** Georgia, 8 pt. For reference sources in languages other than English, please refer to the end of this description, to the section entitled General Remarks.

Note: Use “et al.” when six or more names are given.

Periodicals

Basic Format:

1. J1. K1. Author1, J2. K2. Author2 and J3. K3. Author3, “Name of paper,” *Abbrev. Title of Periodical*, vol. x, no. x, pp. xxx-xxx, abbrev. Month year.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

Books

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, “Title of chapter in the book,” in *Title of His Published Book*, vol.x, xth ed., city of publisher, (only U.S. state), Country: Abbrev. of publisher, year, ch. x, sec. x, pp. xxx–xxx.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source). **Note:** DOI or web-address should refer to the cited section. If this section does not have a separate DOI or web-address, then the DOI or web-address of the book should be given.

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, “Title of Paper” in *Title of Monograph*, vol.x, J1.K1. Editor1 and J2.K2. Editor2, Eds., xth ed., city of publisher, (only U.S. state), country: Abbrev. of Publisher, year, ch. x, sec. x, pp. xxx–xxx.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source). **Note:** DOI or web-address should refer to the cited section. If this section does not have a separate DOI or web-address, then the DOI or web-address of the monograph should be given.

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, "Title of report," Abbrev. Name of Company/Institution, City of Comp./Inst., (only U.S. state), Country, Rep. xxx, year.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

Basic Format:

1. *Name of Manual/Handbook/Database*, xth ed., Abbrev. Name of Company/Institution, City of Company/Institution, Abbrev. State, year, pp. xxx-xxx.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

Published Conference Proceedings

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, "Title of paper," in *Abbreviated Name of Conf.*, (location of conference is optional), year, pp. xxx-xxx.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

Papers Presented at Conferences

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, "Title of paper," presented at the Abbrev. Name of Conf., City of Conf., Abbrev. State, year.

Examples:

1. J. G. Kreifeldt, "An analysis of surface-detected EMG as an amplitude-modulated noise," presented at the 1989 Int. Conf. Medicine and Biological Engineering, Chicago (IL), USA, Nov. 9-12, 1989.

Patents

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, "Title of patent," U.S. Patent x xxx xxx, Abbrev. Month day, year.

DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Example:

1. J. P. Wilkinson, "Nonlinear resonant circuit devices," U.S. Patent 3 624 125, July 16, 1990.

Theses (B.S., M.S.) and Dissertations (Ph.D.)

Basic Format:

1. J. K. Author, "Title of thesis," M.S. thesis / Ph.D. dissertation, Abbrev. Dept., Abbrev. Univ., City of Univ., Abbrev. State, year.
DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

Unpublished

Basic Format :

1. J. K. Author, private communication, Abbrev. Month year.
2. J. K. Author, "Title of paper," unpublished.

Examples:

1. A. Harrison, private communication, May 1995.
2. B. Smith, "An approach to graphs of linear forms," unpublished.

Standards

Basic Format:

1. *Title of Standard*, Standard number, date.
DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

1. *General Requirements for the Competence of Testing and Calibration Laboratories*, BS EN ISO/IEC 17025, 2005.
DOI: 10.3403/03289601U

National and International Documents

Basic Format:

1. Legislative body. (Month day, year). *number/code of the document Title of the Document*.
DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month day, year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Example:

1. National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia. (May 12, 2009). *Закон о заштити од јонизујућих зрачења и о нуклеарној сигурности (Ionizing Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Law)*.

Software

Basic format:

1. J.K. Author, Abbrev. Name of Company, City of Company, Abbrev. State, year, *Name of Software*.
DOI: xx.xxxx/yyyy **or** Retrieved from: <http://www.web.com>; Retrieved on: abbrev. Month Day, Year (this line should be added if the reference has a DOI number **or** is retrieved from an on-line source).

Examples:

1. M. Kuhn, Pfizer Glob., New York (NY), USA, 2012, *The Caret Package*.
Retrieved from: <http://cranr-project.org/web/packages/caret/caret.pdf>; Retrieved on: Feb. 25, 2013.

General Remarks

Unless listed above, web sites and web pages should not be cited.

If the reference source is in a **language other than English**, then the original reference should be listed, and the English translation should be given in brackets. The following example is for a book citation and the same approach should be used for other types of citations.

Example:

1. M. Јоноска, "Притисок на електромагнетен бран. Импулс и маса на електромагнетен бран," во *Електромагнетизам*, т. 2, Скопје, Македонија: Унив. Св. St. Cyril and Methodius, 1994, ch. 8, sec. 18, pp. 332-334.)
